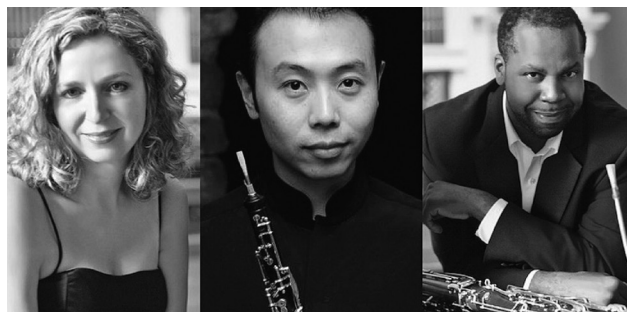

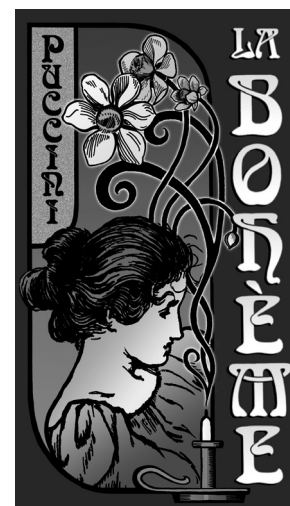


With the John Avison Chamber Orchestra
