




Friday, Oct. 27, 2000 Schubert Ensemble of London

A Message from the Board

As promised at the last concert, we have now finalized our plans for next season. We are pleased to announce that, in addition to the other artists that have already been confirmed, we have been fortunate to secure the celebrated Canadian pianist Janina Fialkowska.

A protégé of the late keyboard giant Artur Rubenstein, she is regarded as one of the leading pianists of her generation. She is justly famous for her commanding and eloquent interpretations of the Classical and Romantic repertoires, most notably the works of Chopin and Liszt. She performs with the world's great orchestras, including the Chicago Symphony, the Cleveland Orchestra, the Philadelphia Orchestra, the Royal Philharmonic, and all of the major Canadian ensembles. In 1990, Ms. Fialkowska was chosen to give the world premiere of Franz Liszt's recently discovered Third Piano Concerto with the Chicago Symphony.

As the Chicago Tribune put it, she is "a superb pianist with rare poetic feeling and lyrical elegance". This concert is sure to be an exciting event.

The critics have been equally kind to the other artists set to perform for you next season. The Nathaniel Dett Chorale has been described as "singing with that elusive combination of vigor and refinement as a new force in Canadian choral singing".

The Schubert Ensemble of London is this year's winner of the Royal Philharmonic Society Award for best Chamber Ensemble. In the U.K., they are well known through regular broadcasts on the BBC, appearances at London's major concert halls and touring worldwide. I Musici de Montreal has had its sound described as "perfectly proportioned, delicately sensitive, exquisitely etched, full of grace and delivered with joy".

Violinist Jack Glatzer regularly makes concert tours of the world. Critics hail him as "world class violinist with such a wealth of instrumental beauty at his disposal that one would be tempted to dwell upon his playing exclusively if were not for the fact that his musicianship directs the attention to the music itself".

We have five memorable concerts for the start of the new millennium. Please renew your subscription tonight. We anticipate that we will sell out for next year.
