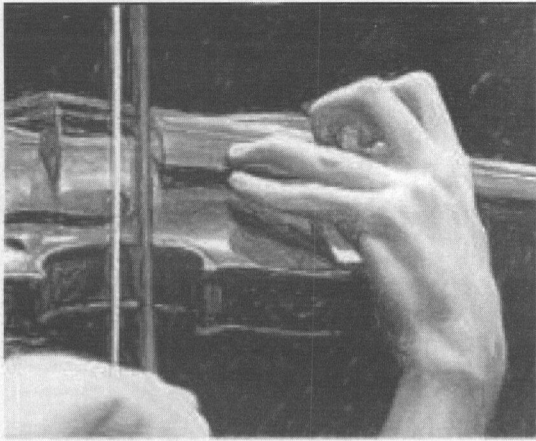

THE PENDERECKI STRING QUARTET

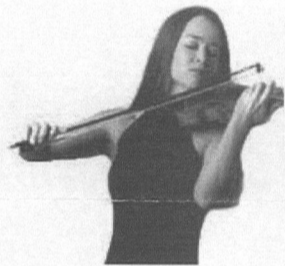

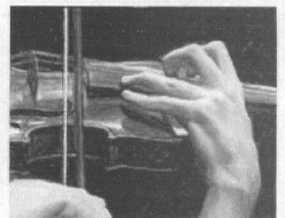
