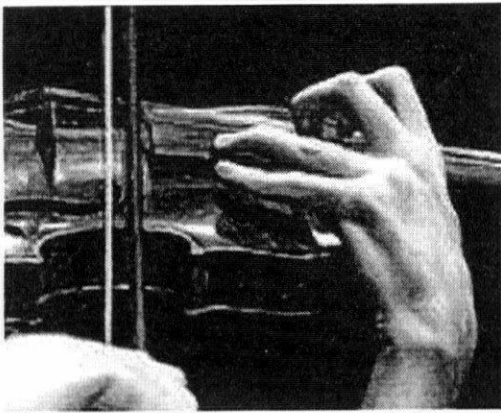

VANCOUVER CHAMBER CHOIR

Canada's outstanding professional vocal ensemble returns to White Rock for a programme of hidden choral treasures. TAFELMUSIK

Celebrating their 25th anniversary, Canada's TAFELMUSIK comes to White Rock immediately following a major tour of Japan. Under the direction of Jeanne Lamont the 17 member touring orchestra will perform works of Bach and Haydn on their finely crafted period instruments. Universally celebrated as the outstanding ensemble of its genre, TAFELMUSIK performs more than 50 concerts each year at home and abroad, and has released more than 60 CDs on Analekta and Sony Classical.

THE WINTER WINDS

Our Artistic Director joins with distinguished flute virtuoso, Lorna McGhee [formerly principal flute of the BBC Symphony, the London Philharmonic and the Academy of St. Martins in the Field], in a programme featuring the noble Bach Suite # 2 for flute and strings, a rarely [if ever] heard trio by opera composer Gaetano Donizetti for flute, bassoon and piano and a work dedicated to Mr. Zukerman by the dean of Canadian composers, John Weinzwieg. It will create a delicious combination, guaranteed to warm up the wintery days of mid-January!

THE VLACH QUARTET (PRAGUE)

Following in the rich tradition of Czech chamber music, the VLACH QUARTET was established in 1982 by Jana Vlachova, daughter of Josef Vlach after whom the original quartet was named. Personnel of the ensemble has remained unchanged since 1985, and the VLACH QUARTET programme always featuring works of leading Czech composers including Dvorak, Smetana, Janacek

JERUSALEM TRIO

Thoughtful and passionate music making, both in live performance and in their highly acclaimed recordings have helped shape a major international career for this remarkable Israeli ensemble. Founded in 1989 under the aegis of the Jerusalem Music Centre and its Director, the late Isaac Stern, the TRIO rapidly rose to world-wide prominence with celebrated recitals in New York, Berlin, Melbourne, and Santiago, and recordings on the JMC and DOREMI labels.

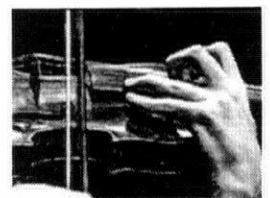
