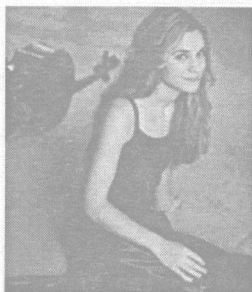

with **PHILIPPE MAGNAN, oboe**

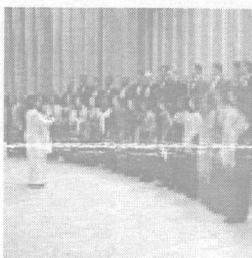

JUPITER STRING QUARTET

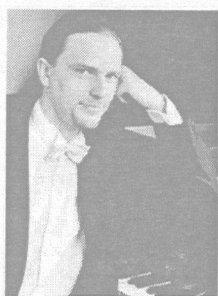

LES VIOLONS DU ROY

The chamber orchestra LES VIOLONS DU ROY takes its name from the renowned string orchestra of the court of French kings. Founded in 1984 by Bernard Labadie, they play chamber music from 17th century to the present. Playing modern instruments, they use Baroque bows and bowing style to capture the style of that era. Well known throughout Canada for concerts and recordings for the CBC, Les Violons du Roy has made hundreds of concert appearances in Europe, England, Norway, Austria, Morocco, Mexico, United States and Canada.

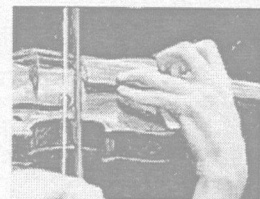
