Currently, Professor of guitar at the distinguished School of Music at Bloomington Indiana, Bolshoy tours extensively for concert societies, symphony orchestras and Festivals and has been featured in the Ottawa International Chamber Music Festival, with the Montreal and Vancouver orchestras and in recital throughout Canada and on the CBC. Last year he completed two TV videos for Bravo TV's The Classic Now series.

Susan Platts, Mezzo soprano

Widely celebrated for her Mahler and Bach interpretations, Canadian mezzo-soprano Susan Platts has made recent debuts at Teatro alla Scala and Teatro di San Carlo as well as return performances with the Cleveland Orchestra, Vancouver Symphony, Philadelphia Orchestra, Malaysian Philharmonic and the Toronto Symphony. Along with her major international concertizing, Ms. Platts spent much of 06-07 in a specially selected "mentor" programme under the tutelage of Jessye Norman.

Vladimir Ovchinnikov, pianist

Ever since his triumphant First Prize at the 1987 Leeds Piano competition, Vladimir Ovchinnikov has been ascending to the pinnacle of a pianistic Valhalla. He has appeared with most of the world's major orchestras including Chicago, Montreal, London, Leipzig Gwandhaus, Zurich Tonhalle Hall and of course with each of the leading Russian orchestras. Among his extensive Melodya recordings is a performance of the Shostakovich piano concerto #1 with the composer's son conducting.

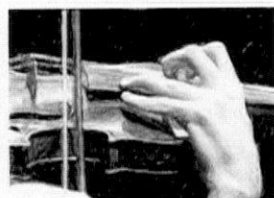
