CONCERT HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE LIVE BROADCASTS ON CBC'S WESTCOAST PERFORMANCE AND RADIO-CANADA'S LES MUSICIENS DU DIMANCHE, PERFORMANCES AT VANCOUVER PRO MUSICA'S ANNUAL SONIC BOOM FESTIVAL, THE LITTLE CHAMBER MUSIC SERIES THAT COULD, UBC SCHOOL OF MUSIC'S RECITAL SERIES AND THE PACIFIC RIM SUMMER MUSIC FESTIVAL IN TOFINO.



Rosanne Wieringa, (flute) is second flautist of the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra. She moved west in 2004 from her position as principal flute with the Regina Symphony Orchestra. She has also participated in the Sweetwater Music Festival in Owen Sound, Ontario and the Gros Morne Summer Festival in Newfoundland.



An active free-lancer, Marea. Chernoff (oboe) has played with Vancouver Opera, Vancouver Symphony, CBC Vancouver Orchestra, National Broadcast Orchestra, Canada West Chamber Orchestra, Ballet BC, Sinfonia of the North Shore, Turning Point, Abbotsford Symphony and Prince George Symphony.



Clarinetist A.K. Coope (clarinet) performs frequently with the Vancouver and Victoria Symphonies, the Vancouver Opera Orchestra, Turning Point Ensemble, the Vancouver New Music Ensemble, and Victoria's Aventa Ensemble. She has recorded for many artists including a CD with her own contemporary music ensemble, Standing Wave.



Founding member of the Ad Mare Quintet, **Sophie Dansereau (bassoon)** is contrabassoonist and assistant principal bassoonist of the Vancouver Symphony. She has performed with the Auckland (New Zealand) Philharmonic, the New World Symphony, the Quebec Symphony, and the CBC Radio Orchestra.



Heather Walker (horn) is a member of the Vancouver Opera Orchestra, the Vancouver Island Symphony Orchestra, the Bessborough Brass Quintet, and the Band of the Fifteenth Field Artillery Regiment. She has also performed with the orchestras of Québec City, Trois-Rivieres, and Monterrey (Mexico).

Todd Cope, (clarinet) joined the clarinet section of the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra in September 2011. Prior to that he was a member of the New World Symphony in Miami Beach. He has also performed with the Sun Valley Summer Symphony and the Scottish Chamber Orchestra.



Steve Denroche (horn) is a member of the Vancouver Opera Orchestra. He was founding member and arranger for the brass group Cornucopia, and has performed with the Vancouver, Winnipeg, and Victoria Symphonies, the Winnipeg Ballet and the National Ballet of Canada.



Ingrid Chiang (bassoon) is currently in her tenth season as the Vancouver Opera Orchestra's principal bassoonist. She has also played with the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra in Kuala Lumpur. She performs regularly with the Turning Point Ensemble, Sonic Boom, and for Pro Musica.

For sixty two years, our Artistic Director, bassoonist George Zukerman plied the international touring circuit- championing his instrument as soloist. Hailed world-wide as "The High Priest of the bassoon", the "Paganini of the bassoon" and even the "Eddie Van Halen of the bassoon", he has recently retired from the performing stage. 
