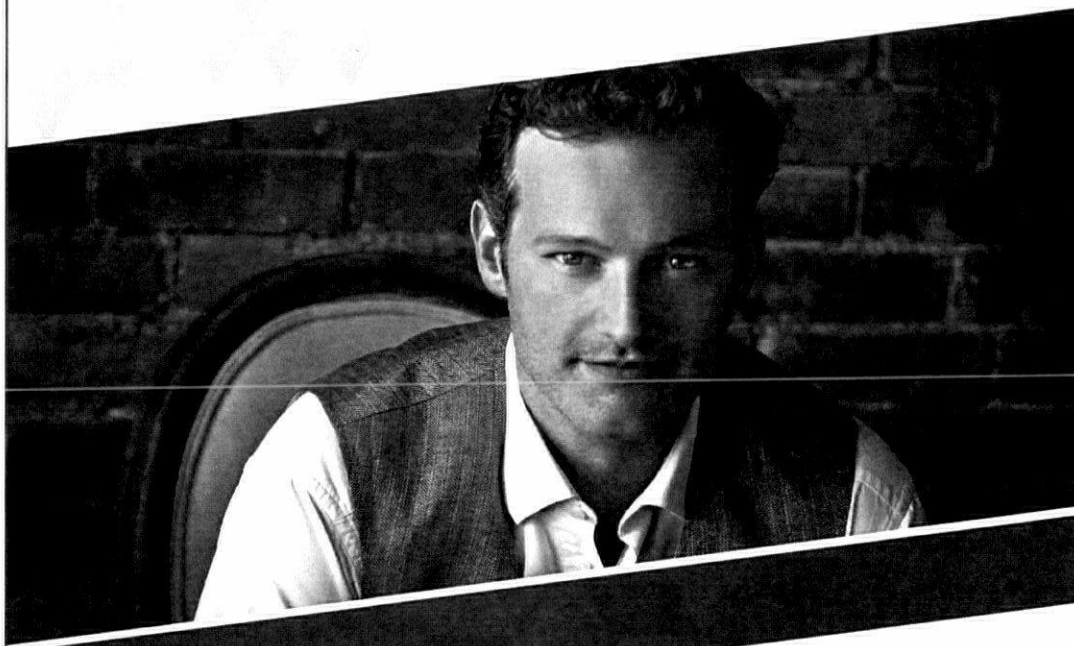

About the Artists

Jens Lindemann is hailed as one of the most celebrated trumpet soloists in his instrument's history and was recently named "International Brass Personality of the Year" (Brass Herald). Mr. Lindemann has played in every major concert venue in the world: from the Philharmonics of New York, Los Angeles, London, and Berlin to Tokyo's Suntory Hall. His career has ranged from appearing internationally as an orchestral soloist, performing at London's 'Last Night of the Proms' and a solo Command Performance for the Queen of England. He has also won major awards ranging from Grammy and Juno nominations to winning the prestigious Echo Klassik in Germany. Classically trained at the renowned Juilliard School in New York, Mr. Lindemann's proven ability to perform as a diverse artist places him at the front of a new generation of musicians, as one of the world's most exciting trumpet soloists. Mr. Lindemann is a Yamaha Artist and performs exclusively on 24K gold-plated trumpets.

Larry Knopp began his career as acting principal trumpet of the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra at the age of 20. He has been a member of Orchestra London, Hamilton Philharmonic, and CBC Radio Orchestra, as well as the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra; and is currently principal trumpet of the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra. A frequent soloist with each of these orchestras, Mr. Knopp has also performed and recorded with the Boston Symphony Orchestra, the New York Philharmonic brass and with the Three Tenors. A present faculty member at UBC, he has also taught at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester. Mr. Knopp is a Yamaha Artist.

Vancouver based **Kristian Alexandrov**, pianist and percussionist, represents the merging of classical and popular musical styles in a single persona. Born in Sofia, Bulgaria, he has been exposed to a wide variety of world music styles, including Bulgarian folk, Classical, Afro-Cuban and Contemporary Jazz. Mr. Alexandrov has firmly entrenched himself in the Canadian music scene -not only as a performer but as an active composer, clinician, and producer including acting as Musical Director for the celebration of Calgary Stampede's 100th Anniversary.

Scottish born, Edmonton based composer, **Allan Gilliland** has written music for a wide variety of instruments and ensembles. His music has been performed and broadcast by ensembles around the world, including the Boston Pops, the St. Lawrence String Quartet, the Scottish Chamber Orchestra and the brass section of the New York Philharmonic. Mr. Gilliland has been composer-in-residence for both the Festival of the Sound (Parry Sound) and the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra. His *Dreaming of the Masters III* was given its North American premiere by Jens Lindemann and the Edmonton Symphony at Carnegie Hall in 2012, and his album *O Music* won 'best Classical composition' at the Western Canadian Music Awards. Well known as an arranger for every combination of instruments, Mr. Gilliland is presently Chair of the Music Dept. and Head of Composition at Grant MacEwan University in Edmonton.
