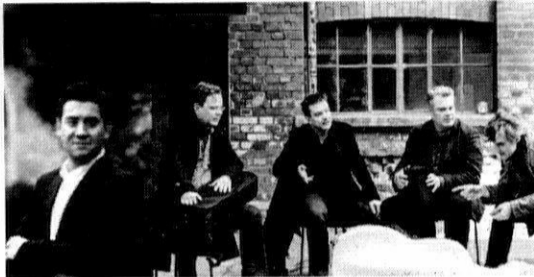


4 | FRIDAY, JANUARY 15, 2016 | Winter Winds | Concertante

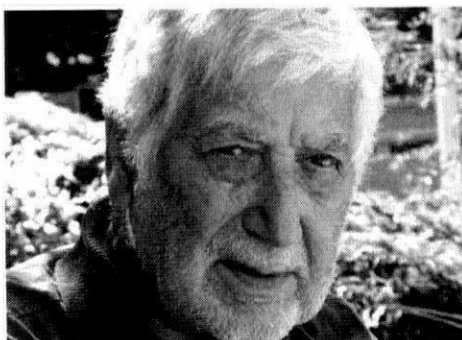

7 | FRIDAY, APRIL 8, 2016 | István Várdai, cellist




