### Tenor Charles Daniels with members of the Pacific Baroque Orchestra led by conductor Alexander Weimann

The great English tenor Charles Daniels joins forces with the Pacific Baroque Orchestra and conductor Alexander Weimann for a mixed programme of music from the 16th to 18th centuries inspired by myths from Ovid's Metamorphosis. Mr. Daniels has a prolific recording legacy having made over ninety recordings ranging from the earliest Renaissance music through to the contemporary repertoire.
