Back by popular demand, the Vancouver Cantata Singers will mesmerize and transport the audience with their unique vocal versatility and sensibility. Be it cobalt, azure, ultramarine, grey, periwinkle or any other shade, the colour blue represents not only nature's images of water, sea and sky, blue evokes tranquility, serenity, imagination, and the depths of trust, wisdom, and peace. The Vancouver Cantata Singers' BLUE programme will feature Standford's *The Bluebird*, Bingham's *The Drowned Lovers*, Gorecki's *Wislo Szara*, and a new commission by White Rock Concerts' own Marcel Bergmann.
